COVID-19 ANTIBODY TESTING

SARS-CoV-2 IgG Ab ELISA

Dear Physicians and Staff,

We are now offering our SARS-CoV-2 IgG Antibody ELISA test to help identify patients who have been exposed to the SARS-CoV-2 virus strain that causes coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).

Our SARS-CoV-2 IgG Ab test is an enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (ELISA) used for the qualitative detection of IgG antibodies to SARS-CoV-2.

It is intended to aid in identifying individuals with an immune response to SARS-CoV-2, indicating recent or prior infection. It is not intended to diagnose or exclude recent SARS-CoV-2 infection.
